1. Head south on Camino Aguajito toward Fremont St - 49 ft
2. Turn left to merge onto CA-1 N - 5.4 mi
3. Take exit 406 for Fort Ord Main Entrance - 0.4 mi
4. Slight right at Light Fighter Dr/Main Gate Entrance Fort Ord - 0.6 mi
5. Turn left at Colonel Durham St/Durham Rd - 0.5 mi
6. Turn left at 6th Ave - 0.2 mi
7. Turn left at Campus Center - 243 ft
